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Ensure that you are using the correct web address for accessing the Netgear extender login page. In some cases, users accidentally enter incorrect URLs in the address bar and face an issue. Therefore, always double-check the URL before hitting the Enter button.

Moreover, if you are a MAC operating system user, then mywifiext.net will not work for you. You are required to enter mywifiext.local to access the Netgear setup wizard from your MAC device.

Important Note: You can also access the Netgear extender setup page using the default IP address i.e. 192.168.1.250 from your WiFi-enabled device.

Update Your Web Browser

You need to check if you are accessing an updated version of the Internet browser. If not, then this might also be reason behind the mywifiext.local not working issue. Therefore, update your web browser to its latest version or switch to another updated web browser to resolve the issue.

Reset Your Extender

If none of the above troubleshooting methods work for you, then you should consider resetting your Netgear extender to the default factory settings and re-configure it from scratch. This might help you to resolve the issue you are currently facing. However, many users aren't aware of the process to reset their Netgear extender. If you are also the one, then here we have listed some simple steps to reset your Netgear extender.

You are required to locate the Reset button on your Netgear extender.

Once located, press and hold the reset button using a pin-pointed object till the LEDs start flashing.

Then, your WiFi extender will restart automatically and be restored to default factory settings.

Now, re-configure your Netgear extender and connect your WiFi-enabled device to Netgear_ext to enjoy the internet services in a hassle-free manner.

Are you facing mywifiext.local not working issue most of the time when trying to access the Netgear extender login page? Well, you are not alone experiencing this kind of issue. Many Netgear users have reported this issue with their Netgear extender. Therefore, here we have

arrived with some basic troubleshooting techniques to fix the mywifiext local not working issue at home. You are just required to take a look at the below section, you might find it helpful.

Reboot Your Extender

Before executing any other troubleshooting hack, we suggest rebooting your Netgear extender as it will remove minor technical glitches which might be the reason behind the mywifiext.local not working issue.

Disconnect your Extender from your WiFi-enabled device and turn it off.

Unplug it from the power source.

Wait for a couple of minutes before plugging it again into the power supply.

Turn it on and re-connect it to the WiFi-enabled device.

Now, check by accessing the mywifiext.local page if the issue has been resolved or not. If not, then head further to the next step.

Verify Internet Connection

Check whether your device is getting proper Internet signals. If you are connected through a wired connection, inspect your Ethernet cable. Any damage to the Ethernet cable can cause loss of internet connection which might be the reason behind the issue. Therefore, change the Ethernet cable with a new one. If you are using a wireless connection, then check whether your devices are placed within the range of the Netgear router as a stable internet connection is required to work efficiently with the Netgear WiFi extender.

Check the Power Source

Make sure that the power outlet through which your WiFi extender is connected doesn't have any kind of damage. Sometimes broken or short-circuited wall socket can cause a power outage and you can get stuck with an issue. Therefore, if you find any damage to the power outlet, then try to plug your WiFi extender into another socket. Moreover, don't forget to check the condition of your AC cable as its needs to be damaged-free for proper functioning.
